Cookie Dough Deliveries are Tuesday, November 10th, after school and during conference time, in the Hawthorne gym.

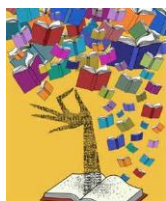
Please come pick up orders, especially large ones! Quick delivery is also important for the cookie dough buckets. Thank you!
